I, Lion Manas Maisnam, Secretary Lions Club of Imphal on behalf of the Board of Directors of Lions Club of Imphal have the pleasure to present the Club Report for the period 1^{st} July 2022 to date.

About the Club:

Lions Club of Imphal was inaugurated on 14th March 1968 and chartered on 22nd June 1968. The club has dedicated more than 54 years to humanitarian service. The Club has produced 1 PMJF and 14 MJF members, which includes 3 in the current Lionistic Year 2022-23.

The Club has produced three District Governors. Our Club has organized 5 District Cabinet Installation and District Cabinet Meetings in the years 1985, 1991, 2007, 2015 and 2022 respectively.

The present Board of Directors is headed by Lion Dr. P. Brajamani Singh as the President and was installed on 22nd June 2022 at Lions Service Centre, Sangaiprou Airport Road by the installation cum induction officer, Lion M. Gojendra Singh, MJF, SCA Past District Governor, District 322D. The Lionistic Year commenced on a joyful note by welcoming the District Governor on his return from Montreal, on 1st July 2022.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT:

- 1. During the period under report, the Club has convened 16 BOD meetings and 11 Regular Meetings.
- 2. On the day of installation of new BOD members of the Club, 6 new members were inducted. During the period under report, 2 new members were added.
- 3. On 16th and 17th July 2022, the Club, along with Lions Club of Imphal City had hosted the Installation of District Cabinet of District 322D for LY 2022-23 and First Cabinet Meeting at Sangai Hall, Hotel Imphal. Lion VK Luthra, PID was the Chief Guest and installation officer.
- 4. The Club has paid the 1st semi-annual international and district fees and also had reported Membership Reporting Status online at MyLCI.
- 5. During the period under report, 3 member of the Club became Melvin Jones Fellow (MJF). They are Lion Dr. Brajamani Singh, Lion Dr. A. Meina Singh and Lion Manas Maisnam Singh.
- 6. Many members from the Club including Lion Dr. P. Brajamani Singh, Lion Manas Maisnam, Lion W. Inaobi Singh, Lion H. Manikumar Singh, Lion W. Bhaktaraj Singh, Lion M. Nandeshwor Singh, Lion I. Rajanikanta Singh, Lion Th. Imomacha Singh, Lion K. Chaoba had attended Charter Nite, installation and induction of almost all the major Clubs in the State, notable among them are- Lions Club of Imphal Valley, Lions Club of Imphal Leimarol, Lions Club of Canchipur, Canchipur Centurion, Canchipur Greater,

Canchipur Palace, Lions Club of Nambol, Lions Club of Ningthoukhong, Lions Club of Wangjing, Lions Club of Kakching Greater etc.

- 7. On 18th September, 2022 the Club had hosted the 1st DG Advisory Meeting for Zone-I, Region-I of District 322D.
- 8. Lion H. Manikumar, PDG, Lion I. Gojendra, Lion I. Rajanikanta attended a conference on Crime Against Women, held on 30th Sept 2022 organised by Lions Club of Imphal Leimarol. District Governor was the Chief Guest.
- Lion K. Chaoba and Lion A. Bonbirdhwaja took part in the New Members Orientation Programme for Region-I held on 2nd October, 2022 at Lions Club of Ningthoukhong. The programme was also attended by Lion H. Manikumar, PDG, Lion Th. Imomacha on the dias.
- 10. 2nd Cabinet Meeting for District 322D was held at Tinsukia on 16th October, 2022 and was attended by the District Governor and many Cabinet members and senior members of the Club.

- 12. On 5th November 2022, District Governor presented charter to a new Club viz., Lions Club of Canchipur United which was attended by many senior Lion members of the Club.
- 13. Many members of the Club led by President Lion Dr. P. Brajamani attended the 2nd Charter Night Celebration of Lions Club of Imphal Excellence on 13th November 2022. District Governor was the Chief Guest.
- 14. On 4th December 2022, members of the Club attended the 2nd District Governor's Advisory Committee meeting, for Zone-I, Region-I hosted by Lions Club of Imphal Global.
- 15. On 11th December, the son of Lion L. Swamikanta and daughter of Lion Dr. A. Mahendra were felicitated by the Club on their success in Manipur Civil Service Examination.
- 16. Lion Dr. W. Gopimohan, District Governor, Lion I. Gojendra, Lion M. Nandeshwor, Lion RK Dusharigopal, Lion K. Chaoba and Lion Kh. Sobita from this Club attended the ISAME Forum 2022 at Visakhapatnam.

SERVICE ACTIVITIES REPORT:

A: Environment Project (Permanent Project):

A Tree Plantation programme under "Environment Project" was held on 23rd July 2022 at the campus of Ipa Loyalakpa Brick Fields, Mayanglangjing Taning, Imphal West. An environment awareness lecture for the benefit of the brickfield workers was also delivered by Lion L. Swamikanta Singh.

On 14th August 2022, Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav was celebrated by planting trees under "Environment Project" at Imphal Valley Academy, Ghari Makha Leikai. As a part of the programme, Lion Manas Maisnam delivered an awareness lecture on left handedness for the benefit of the students of the school as 13th August 2022 was International Left Handers' Day. **B: Blood Donation & Awareness (Permanent Project):**

131st Patriots' Day was observed by the Club on 13th August 2022 by offering floral tributes to the fallen heroes, at the Lions Service Centre. Later, a One Day Awareness cum Blood Donation Camp, which is a "Permanent Project" of the Club was held at the Blood Bank of RIMS, Lamphelpat Imphal. The camp was organized in association with Lions Club of Imphal Valley, Lions Club of Imphal Northern Hemisphere, Indian Red Cross Society, Manipur State & Imphal

West branches and Department of Transfusion Medicine, RIMS. About 30 units of blood were collected.

C: Eye Screening at Lions Eye Hospital (Permanent Project):

Eye Screening OPD which is a "Permanent Project" of the Club had resumed since 11th September 2022 and it is held on 2nd and 4th Sunday of every month from 10:00AM to 12:00 noon at Lions Eye Hospital, Sangaiprou. During the period under report, eye screening OPD was held in September, October (including Health Camp & Special OPD on World Sight Day), November & December 2022 along with distribution of free medicines was done for **215 patients** under Lion Dr. L. Chaoba Singh.

D: Honouring of Teachers (Permanent Project):

The Club had honoured 4 (four) retired teachers on 11th September 2022 for their dedicated and exemplary service as a teacher. They are (1) Shri Sanasam Meghachandra Singh, Retd. Principal Manipur College, (2) Shri Thounaojam Manglemba Singh, Retd. Head Master Yumnam Huidrom High School, (3) Smt. Konsam Loidang, Retd. Head Mistress (i/c) of Khonghampat Primary School and (4) Smt. Wangkhem Basanti Devi, Retd. Faculty, Regional Health & Family Welfare Training Centre, Porompat.

E: Relieving the Hunger (One Multiple One Activity & Permanent Project):

Continuing the "World-Wide Service Week", on 17th September, 2022 under One Multiple one Activity of "Feed the Hungry", the Club, had donated food items like rice (370 Kgs, equivalent to about 1000 meals), potatoes, dal, dry fish, edible oil, onions etc. worth about **Rs. 19,000/-** to Old Age Home at Langol. The amount was raised by members of the Club.

B: Peace Poster Contest on 25th September, 2022 (Permanent Project):

Peace Poster Contest, 2022 was held on 25th September 2022 at Lions Service Centre on the theme "Lead with Compassion". The 1st prize of Rs. 5000/- sponsored by Lion L. Ibomcha was won by Pheedam Sinam of RK Mission School. 2nd Prize of Rs. 3000/- sponsored by Lion Manas Maisnam was won by Ningombam Priscilla of KV Leimakhong while 3rd prize of Rs. 2000/- sponsored by Lion K. Chaoba was won by Angela Heikrujam of KV Lamphelpat. Three consolation prizes were also given.

G: 126th Birth Anniversary of Lamyanba Hijam Irabot on 30th September, 2022:

On 30th September, 2022, the Club had observed the 126th Birth Anniversary of Lamyanba Hijam Irabot. Floral tributes were paid to the leader and Social Service was done at the Club Service Centre premises. An Environment Awareness lecture was delivered on the theme of "Ozone layer" by Dr. Koijam KK Bhushan, Associate Prof & HOD Dept. of Environment Science, Dhanamanjuri University. A short film titled "The Impact of Melvin Jones" was also screened on the occasion.

H: Observance of World Service Day on 8th October 2022:

On 8th October, 2022 Lions Club of Imphal in association with Lions Club of Imphal North had observed World Service Day by donating the following items: (i) Plastic Chair (ii) Dust Bin, (iii) Carrom Board set, (iv) LED Bulbs and (v) one sound box & microphone set to "Ahal Laman gi Potha Shang" at the campus of HWC Awang Wabgai, Imphal West. The total worth of the items donated was approx. **Rs. 15,000/-**.

I: Multi-Disciplinary Health Camp at Kanglatongbi on 9th October 2022 (Permanent Project):

The Club along with Lions Club of Imphal North and Lions Club of Imphal Northern Hemisphere and in association with United Youth Club, Kanglatongbi had organized a Multi-Disciplinary Health Camp at Kanglatongbi Bazar on 9th October, 2022. Check-up/ Screening was done for (i) General Medicine (108 patients), (ii) Pediatrics (20 patients), (iii) Diabetes Detection (68 patients), (iv) Eye Screening (104 patients, reported at C above also) and (v) Gynecology (12 patients). Medicines worth about **Rs. 25,000/-** were also distributed free.

J: World Sight Day on 13th October 2022:

Lions Club of Imphal had observed World Sight Day on 13th October 2022. A special eye screening OPD for inmates and supervisors of Nabalini Astham Children Home for Girls, Ghari was held (mentioned at C above). Altogether eye-screening was done for **30 girl inmates & supervisors**. On the occasion, Lion Dr. Kh. Rajendra Singh, District Chairman, Sight First, District 322D delivered a lecture for the awareness of the girls of Nabalini Astham Children Home. A film on the life of Helen Keller which included an enactment of her historic "Knights of the Blind" speech delivered in 1925 was also screened. District Governor attended as Chief Guest.

K: Observance of UN Day on 24th October 2022 (Permanent Project):

UN Day was observed on 24th October 2022 with 30th State Level Debating Competition for Senior Secondary & College students on the theme "Reformation of UNO is a must in a Dynamic World of 21st Century". 31 students from 7 institutes took part. Sainik School won both the Team Championship & Runners-Up trophy. In individual prizes Akoijam Athouba of Sainik School won the 1st prize of Rs. 7000 (sponsored by the Club), Alex Laishram and Kh. Minerva of the same school tied for 2nd prize, winning Rs. 4000 each (co-sponsored by Lion Kh. Brajakumar and Lion K. Chaoba).

L: Diabetes Detection (One Multiple One Activity & Permanent Project):

As observance of Diabetes Awareness Week on the theme "Knock Out Diabetes", One Multiple One Activity of MD-322, Lions Club of Imphal in association with TRAU Kwakeithel had organized a "One Day Diabetes Detection cum Awareness Camp" at Kwakeithel Bazar on 12th November, 2022. Altogether, diabetes detection along with awareness was done for 80 persons. Diabetes Awareness pamphlets were also distributed to about 40 vendors, shopkeepers, customers etc. at Kwakeithel Bazar (total benefitted is 80+40 = 120). An awareness video message was also shared at the official Facebook page & Twitter handle of the Club.

By accounting the 68 diabetes detection at the medical camp held at Kanglatongbi, a total of **188 persons** (120+68) had diabetes screening done & awareness given.

M: Fund Raising:

On Sunday, 11th December, 2022 a Fund Raising project in the form of lottery was held at Lions Service Centre, Sangaipirou. A sum of approximately **Rs. 2,63,000/-** could be raised from it. This fund will be used for various service activities of the Club during the Lionistic Year.

N: Honouring of Past Presidents:

As a part of the celebration of New Year Eve on 31st December, 2022 Past Presidents of the Club were honoured by presenting simple gifts.

All the activities of the Club mentioned above are reported at MyLion, news media and social media sites of the Club.
