The official Emblem of the International Association of Lions clubs, as designed by Maurice Blink of Santa Barbara, California was approved by the Board on December 31, 1921.

The large "L" in the centre stands for Liberty, Law, Labour, Love, Life, Loyalty and of course Lions. The encompassing circle symbolizes Lions Clubs and members the world over bound together into one. The profile of two Lions looking into two directions represent Lions looking everywhere for opportunities to serve. While one Lion symbolizes each member of the organization contemplating proudly on the past achievements, the other stands for lions looking ahead towards a great future for Lionism. The word 'Lion' at the top represents Association & the word International signifies that it is International in character.

Purple and Gold – The official colours of the Association were adopted as early as in 1917 during the first convention. The traditional colour of strength, courage and tireless dedication to a cause,PURPLE symbolizes loyalty to one's country and friends and for the integrity of the mind & heart, GOLD signifies sincerity of purpose, liberty in judgment, surety in life and generosity of mind heart and spouse towards one's fellowmen.

WE SERVE – The International Board approved and the delegates at the 37th convention at NEW YORK city,July 7-10,1954, adopted WE SERVE as the official motto of the Association. The phrase sent in by a Lion from Canada, was chosen from amongst more than 6,000 entries received from all over the world in response to a call to suggest a motto for the organization.



LIBERTY, INTELLIGENCE, OUR NATION'S SAFETY - The interpretation given by Halsted Ritter of Denver, Colorado, U.S.A., TO THE LETTER **L-I-O-N-S** during the third convention in Chicago, July 9-12,1919,was adopted as the official Slogan of the Association.

FOUNDING FATHER OF LIONS MELVIN JONES



Some are born great, greatness is thrust on few; and some achieve greatness – Shakespeare Selfless service and sacrifice, devotion and dedication towards the cause of less fortunate, makes a man truly great One truly great man was our founder MELVIN JONES.

BOUQUET

Melvin Jones was born on January 13, 1879 at Fort Thomas Arizona, the son of an United States Army Captain who commanded a troop of scouts. Later, his father was transferred and the family moved east. As a young man, Jones made his home in Chicago, Ilinois and associated himself with an insurance firm Jonhson & Higgins and in 1913 formed his own Melvin Jones Insurance Agency.

He soon joined the Business Circle, a businessmen's Luncheon group, and was shortly elected secretary. This group was one of many at that time devoted solely to promoting the financial interest of their members. Because of their limited appeal, they were destined to disappear. Melvin Jones, however, had other plans. "What if these men," he asked, "Who are successful because of their drive, intelligence and ambition, were to put their talents to work improving their communities ?" Thus, at his invitation, delegates from many clubs met at Chicago to lay the groundwork for such an organization and on June 7, 1917, Lions Clubs International was born. It was stipulated that clubs were not to be social in nature nor were members permitted to promote their own business interests.

Lionism's founder was also recognised as a leader outside the association. One of his greatest honours was in 1945 when he represented Lions Clubs International as a consultant in San Francisco, California at the organization of the United Nations.

Melvin Jones, the man whose personal code, "You can't get very far until you start doing something for somebody else" – became a guiding principle for public-spirited people the world over. Died on June 1, 1961, at 82 years of age.

He is no more with us but he is and will ever be with millions and millions of committed Lions who live fully to their own proclamation WE SERVE.

His life was a benediction. His vision is an inspiration.

I, Lion Manas Maisnam, Secretary Lions Club of Imphal on behalf of the Board of Directors of Lions Club of Imphal have the pleasure to present the Club Report for Lionistic Year 2022-23.

ABOUT THE CLUB :

Lions Club of Imphal was inaugurated on 14th March 1968 and chartered on 22nd June 1968. The Club has completed 55 years of dedicated humanitarian service. The Club has so far produced 2 PMJFs and 15 MJF members. The Club has been awarded International President's Excellence Award for the years 2014 - 15, 2017-18, 2019-20 and 2021-22.

The Club has produced three District Governors. Our Club has hosted 5 District Conference in the years 1985, 1991, 2007, 2015 and 2023 respectively.

The present Board of Directors is headed by Lion Dr. P. Brajamani Singh as the President and was installed on 22nd June 2022 at Lions Service Centre, Sangaiprou Airport Road. - **Donation to DFF:** 13 members from the Club had donated a total of Rs. 29,000/- to DFF during the Lionistic Year 2022-23.
- Assistance to Relief Camps: During May and June 2023, Lions Club of Imphal took part in the collective effort of Fraternity of Lions Clubs of Manipur region under District 322D in providing financial and material assistance to Relief Camps at Khurai, Sagolmang, Moirang, Kakching, Wangjing, Ningthoukhong, Keirak, Bishnupur where affected persons of the ethnic violence are taking shelter. The members of the Club had raised Rs. 30,000/- for this project.
- Assistance to Children Home: The Club members raised Rs. 15,000/- which was handed over to Children Home, Kabo Leikai (Dewlahland) on 22nd May 2023. The Home was completely damaged after it had caught fire from adjoining buildings during the ethnic violence on 4th May, 2023.

HISTORY OF HOLLYWOOD & ITS SILENT FILM ERA

In 1892 American inventor Thomas Alva Edison, along with his assistant, William Kennedy Laurie Dickson developed a device to capture movements on continuous film reel. The device, called *Kinetograph* used 35mm film reel with perforations at the edges which is the standard gauge for movies still today. The moving images of Kinetograph could be seen using another device called Kinetoscope. It was a box-like coin-operated device in which only one person could watch and lacked the technology to project for mass consumption. Edison's company made many short films and these were shown to using Kinetoscope at places like fair, exhibition etc.

Projection of films on a screen was achieved in 1895 by the Lumiere brothers in Paris when they showed a 46 seconds duration scene of workers leaving Lumiere Factory. This was followed by more films, all under one minute. From the solitary experience of Kinetoscope, film has now got an audience. The effort to add sound to films began right from the days of Edison's invention and continued till around 1910. The major issue in this effort was amplification of sound so as to enable a considerable audience to hear and synchronization with lip movement on screen. Hence the effort ended.

The first American film with a proper storyline was The Great Train Robbery made in 1903. By around 1905 films became a very popular medium in United States. Immigrants workers from Europe formed the major chunk of audience as it was a cheap medium without the barrier of language (films were silent). Abandoned restaurants, churches were quickly converted to movie halls. New York became the hub of film making in US. Studios, without roofs were built atop tall buildings which could be revolved so as to align to sunshine. On the other hand, established film-makers wanted royalty from independent producers who were making films using the technology developed by their Companies. The established film-makers often employed gangsters to disturb filming by independent film-makers or to destroy equipment. The 'independents' too hired gangsters to counter the attacking goons. This cat and mouse game continued for some years. In the end, frustrated by constant disturbances, some independent producers flee 4000 km west to Los Angeles. The place was found to be ideal for film-making with more than 350 days of sunshine a year. Even if the hired gangsters reach there, the producers could easily sneak to nearby Mexico. While searching for locations, the producers found a small settlement with vast expanse of fruit plantation. The name of the place was Hollywood. By around 1910, many US film makers shifted base to Hollywood. The Nestor Studios, which was the first studio in Hollywood was established in 1911. By 1913, almost all the US films were made by film companies based in Hollywood.

Despite the growth of American film industry in Hollywood, they lagged behind their European counterparts. While the European film-makers were producing full length feature films of good cinematic quality, American films were mainly concentrating on shorter films. Some film-makers even copied European films almost scene by scene. The trend was broken by Cecil B. Demille who made the Squaw Man in 1914 which was the first ever full length feature film made in Hollywood. This was followed by Griffith's The Birth of a Nation (1915) which was a huge success. The film was around 2 hours & 10 minutes long and despite its controversial content, it is considered to be a masterpiece for its brilliant filming, narrative technique and editing. Griffith quickly banked on the success of The Birth of a Nation and made Intolerance in 1916. The film was a big budget marked by massive sets and was 3 hours 30 minutes long at the time of original release. However it was a huge commercial failure. But it is considered to be a landmark film for its unorthodox theme and techniques. In fact, D.W. Griffith introduced filming techniques like long shot, medium shot and close-up. He was also the pioneer of editing and cutting which enriched cinematic value. During the decade of 1910s, alongside serious film-makers, comedy film-maker Mack Sennett churned out many slapstick comedy films. Countless successful silent film actors began their career in his films. Some of them are- Charles Chaplin, Mabel Normand, Roscoe "Fatty" Arbuncle, Gloria Swanson etc.

The pace of film-making in Hollywood picked up quickly. New studios were established. Notable among them were- Keystone Studios (1912), Fox Film (1915), Paramount Studios (1916), Goldwyn Studios (1917) and Chaplin Studios (1917).

In 1914, First World War broke out resulting in decline of European film industry. During the period of the war, American film industry grew leaps and bounds. By the end of the War, the European film industry collapsed. Hollywood thus became the cynosure of movie industry in the world. Many film personalities from Europe migrated to Hollywood. They were in great demand also, for their well-chiselled looks. Actors like Vilma Banky, Rudolph Valentino, Pola Negri, Alla Nazimova, and later Greta Garbo came to Hollywood and started working for various studios, churning out smashing hits. Star system started with actors like Douglas Fairbanks, Charles Chaplin, Rudolph Valentino, Mary Pickford, Lillian Gish, Theda Bara, Colleen Moore, Buster Keaton, shining bright on Hollywood's cinematic firmament. Theda Bara was Hollywood's first screen vamp and a personality who was entirely promoted by the publicity department of a studio. Her most famous film was *Cleopatra*, released in 1917. The film is considered lost except for about 20 seconds fragment. In fact, excepting 2 films and some few seconds fragment of a few more films, all other films of Theda Bara are lost.

Films, which began as a cheap source of entertainment for migrant class people had transformed into a world of business and glamour. Luxurious palatial movie halls came up. Moviegoing became the favourite indulgence of high and mighty. Film magazines started publication which reported spicy gossips, scandals and peccadillos about the famous film stars of that time. Film reviews were also carried by such magazines. Adoring fans quickly lapped them up with great enthusiasm.

The sign HOLLYWOOD was put up as HOLLYWOODLAND in 1923 to publicize a proposed real estate development venture. The sign was supposed to be a temporary installation. Ironically, the real estate venture failed and the sign became permanent (the word LAND was removed later) to become one of world's most famous landmarks.

The period from 1920 to 1927 can be said to be the Golden Age of Silent films in Hollywood. Some remarkable films of this period were *The Kid* (1921), *The Four Horsemen of The Apocalypse* (1921), *The Sheik* (1921 & later *The Son of the Sheik*, 1926), *A Woman of Paris* (1923), *Greed* (1924), *Ben Hur* (1925). The seemingly never-ending dream was to end. A new competitor to cinema emerged in early 1920s- Radio. Due to the immense popularity of radio, audience in movie halls dropped drastically. Further, cine-goers wanted to hear their favourite stars' voice in movies. To counter the immense popularity of radio, grander and more lavish films were produced which were all ironically advertised on radio! Also, sound amplification was achieved and around the same time, inventor Lee de Forest had developed sound on film process wherein sound was recorded in wave-forms on the edge of film strip, which were converted to sound during projection thereby achieving synchronization with lip movement on screen. The issue of sound amplification and synchronization was thus solved but studio heads considered de Forest's invention to be an impractical passing fad and concentrated on silent films which were doing very well commercially. But some documentaries and newsreels were carrying synchronised sound. De Forest himself made short films with sound on experimental basis which were used to publicise his new technology.

Technology apart, introduction of sound in movies meant a huge investment in terms of building new sound stages, acquiring new cameras and equipments, rewiring of movie theatres etc. Further, a silent film had world-wide market as the inter-titles could be changed to multiple languages easily. In the case of talking pictures, it was not possible to release in multiple languages due to limitation of technology at that time. Major Hollywood studios had thus reached an understanding to adopt "wait and watch" approach. If at all they are to convert to sound films, they agreed to adopt a single technology. Only Warner Bros stood apart from the rest and went on to make the first sound film, *The Jazz Singer* released in 1927. In fact, it was not even a full sound film. Only a few scenes contained perfectly synced sound. Rest had inter-titles like silent films. The film was a huge success and audience longed for more talking pictures (or talkies in short). Very soon, remaining studios had to take the plunge and started producing talkies.

But the advent of talkies proved to be the dead-knell for many silent stars, especially from Europe and Latin American countries. Their English speaking and diction were not suitable for talkies. Even many English speaking actors failed the voice test. The microphone in the studios hung like the proverbial Damocles Sword for them. Some studio heads, who were not in good terms with their silent stars used the voice test to tweak their reasonably good voices to make it deliberately bad, thereby killing their career. Within a span of about 2 years the career of many silent stars was over. Also, a large number of musicians who were providing live orchestra at silent film theatres lost their jobs. Only a handful of silent film actors like Charles Chaplin, Lillian Gish, Gloria Swanson survived the transition to sound films. MGM Studio was so scared of Greta Garbo's thick English accent that they made her talking picture, *Anna Christie* only in 1930.

The craze for sound swept Hollywood to such an extent that acting and all other aspects of film-making became secondary. The emphasis was only on capturing sound. Camera-work was also greatly restricted as it was placed inside a phone-booth like kiosk for sound insulation. Microphones were placed inside or behind various props like flower vase, bouquet etc. Hence acting was also greatly restrained as the actors could not move very far away from the microphones. The hardship faced during the transition from silent to sound films was nicely parodied in the film *Singing in the Rain* (1951). Interestingly, a silent film set was a very noisy place with the director constantly shouting instructions along with the sound of camera and other equipments. In a talkies set, there was pindrop silence. The actors were left "orphaned" by the director. By 1930, perfect synchronisation of sound with film could be achieved and silent film era was over.

Today, more than 70% of Hollywood's silent films are lost. Many of the surviving films are in deplorable condition. Nitrate decay, accidental fire due to highly inflammable nitrate compound in the films and deliberate destroying of films & negatives by studios to save space are the major factors. Inside the unmarked film vaults, fading images of the once-popular stars are trapped in the decaying nitrate spools of silent films. They are unsuccessfully trying to tell stories of filmdom's most glorious era, in the language they know best- Silence.

GLOBAL ACTION TEAM (GAT) - A New Approach in LIONISM

INTRODUCTION

From the very beginning in 1917, Lionism has been a synonym of Service under the motto, *WE SERVE" .And our endeavour is to serve maximum under a new lionistic adage, "Where there is a need, there is a Lion".

The International Leadership first introduced the concept of MERL (Membership, Extension, Retention & Leadership) for the same objective of serving more people, the idea being more members/ hands for more services. However the action under MERL did not produce the desired result fully as the components in charge of Membership, Extension, Retention and Leadership lacked understanding and cohesiveness.

The Leadership, therefore, came up with another concept of GMT (Global Membership Team) and GLT (Global Leadership Team), where the components Membership and Leadership may work together for synergic action. Further, the functioning of GMT and GLT penetrated deep into the working of the Organization (Lions Clubs International), right from the top (International level) down to the bottom (Club level) for better result. For quite some time, the combination of GMT and GLT seemed to be working smoothly and productively. But, the top Leadership felt that there were some drawbacks and loop-holes, particularly in the area of intense service sector. So, the new concept of Global Action Team (GAT) was formed with the addition of another action oriented component known as Global Service Team (GST) for service project activities.

WHAT IS GLOBAL ACTION TEAM

The Global Action Team (GAT) is a Global Network of the World's largest Service Club Organization designed to expand its reach and make a bigger impact in serving 200 million lives per year as its goal. Different constituents are:-

1. Global Membership Team : Delivers tools to find new members and keep Lions coming back

- 2. Global Leadership Team: Empowers leaders through training and support.
- 3. Global Service Team: Energizes service with new resources and new passion.

The concept of GAT was conceived and started implementation during the Lionistic Year 2017-18. It was built with a vision that one day, every need in the world will be served by a Lion or a Leo.

By bringing the three key areas of Lions, i.e. Leadership, Membership and Service together, Lions will create synergy and new opportunities for Lions Clubs to grow and serve so that we we can achieve our goal of impacting 200 million lives per year. Here, Clubs are the centre of action. The new GAT puts the entire Lions Network to work for the Clubs. It will also assist in locating service resources and dynamic project support, identify Leadership development opportunities to empower all Lions, recruit compassionate new members and keep current Lions engaged. In other words, the result will be 'New Energy, New Resources and New Opportunities' with passionate volunteers, dynamic leaders and innovative services, all coming together. International Level:

Only GAT Chairperson is there (Post to be held by One Past International President)

Constitutional Area Level:

Only Coordinators of GMT, GLT & GST are there

Area Leadership Level:

Only Coordinators of GMT, GLT & GST are there.

Multiple Level:

GAT Chairperson (Council Chairperson) Coordinators of GMT, GLT & GST

District Level:

GAT Chairperson (District Governor) Coordinators of GMT, GLT & GST

Club Level:

GAT Chairperson (Club President) Coordinators of GMT, GLT & GST.

HOW THE TEAM WORKS

The Constitutional Area Coordinators of GMT, GLT & GST and the Area Leadership Coordinators of GMT, GLT & GST shall work under the guidance of GAT Chairperson at International level. They shall oversee the performance and functioning of the Multiple level GAT.

At the Multiple level, the GAT shall assist and guide the District level GAT, while the District level GAT shall extend assistance and guidance to the Club level GAT.

In the beginning of the Lionistic Year, 2022-23, the International Leadership felt that the activities of Chartering of new Lions Clubs (Club Extension) should be segregated from the activities of GMT and another component of GAT under the name and style of Global Extension Team (GET)

History of ISAME and Area Forum

ebanon became the 39th country to join Lions Clubs International as the Beirut Lions Club received its Charter on September 4, 1952, sponsored by the Maxico City Lions Club, while the entry of a new country into the Lions Family always cause for celebration, this occasion also marked Lions expansion into new territory – the Middle East. Lions soon began to spread to other nations in this region with Morocco, Jordan and Algeria joining in 1953.

Previously, the Area was known as South Asia, Africa and Middle East (SAAME), subsequently, with larger membership strength in India,, India was incorporotated in the name making it ISSAME (India, South Asia, Africa and Middle East) with effect from 2001-02.

By 2014, Africa boosted clubs in 48 countries and geographic areas with more than 25,000 members, one third of whom were women. Soon, Lions clubs

in Africa was accorded as a seperate constitutional Area States as their membership strength crossed the requisite number of 30,000 in the year 2018-19. Thus, the original constitutional Area, SAAME became ISAAME in 2001-02 and subsequently ISAME in 2018-19, with the removal of Africa.

SAAME or ISAAME or ISAME, so far had produced four International Presidents, namely, (1) (L) Lion Rohit C. Mehta (1992-93); (2) (L) Lion Dr. Ashok Mehta (2005-06); (3) Lion Mahendra Amarasuriya (2007-08) and (4) Lion Dr. Naresh Aggarwal (2017-18).

On July 11, 1964 at the close of 44th International Convention, India gets its 1st International Director in Lion Noshir N. Pundole, the first district Governor (1956-59) of District 304, consisting of the entire Indian peninsula, elected for the 1964-66 term to represent Africa and South Asia who mooted the idea of AREA FORUM.

THE FOLKLORE OF LIONS CLUB OF IMPHAL

Let us elaborate or imagine the gist of the term "Folklore". It means a legend, a myth, mythology, oral-history, a tradition etc. All these epithets contain in one Lions Club of Manipur namely, Lions Club of Imphal, the harbinger of the philosophy of "noblesse- oblige" in the picturesque ancient land of Manipur celebratedly nicknamed "Sanaleibak". Thus, the tradition of Lionism, a yeomen service had taken root in the soil of our motherland Manipur as early as the year 1968. The birth of Lions Club of Imphal was indeed an eventful occasion at that point of time in Manipur.

An important aspect of the institution called "Lionism" pertains to occasions like Charter Night Anniversary, Charter Night Celebrations, Charter Presentation Ceremony etc. Whatsoever the term we may coin but the implication still remains the same. A charter is a document granted by a ruler or a monarch or a government by which an institution like a University or any other establishment could be instituted or created or established and their responsibility and function are also elaborately defined. Like this, only because of the Charter granted by the International Association of Lions Clubs, a Lions Club could enjoy the legitimate status for its own existence as well as function as a philanthropic entity or agency in a specific area demarcated as a District, for example District 322D or Multiple District 322. This may also be something like a geographical or topographical feature defined or established by the International Association of Lions Clubs.

Now let me come to the pertinent date, the 22nd of June 1968 and this was the very day on which Lions Club of Imphal was born or in a wider sense the birth of Lionism in Manipur. And here again, it was always a matter of gratification and humility to remember that Lions Club of Imphal was sponsored by none other than the great Club, called Lions Club of Shillong, the erstwhile state capital of undivided Assam. Lions Club of Imphal was inaugurated on the 14th March 1968 and it was also chartered on the 22nd June of the same year with 30 compassionate Charter members and each one of them a real paragon. The actual position was that the venerated 30 souls had laid down the foundation of Lions Club of Imphal, the "sanctum sanctorum" of Lionism in the state. This, indeed signifies the fact that only after the advent of Lions Club of Imphal, the fragrance of philanthropy or humanitarianism had begun to frolic in the hills and plains of Manipur. At the time of the formation of Lions Club of Imphal, altogether 30 benevolent members were chartered. Lions are homogeneous group of people and they always fall in line to help those who need their support and assistance.

During the early days of Lionism in Manipur, the erstwhile Hotel Imphal near North A.O.C. was engaged as and when required for meetings and other matters concerning Lionism. Not only this, during those bygone days, some Lion leaders from Lions Club of Imphal had to proceed to Shillong

to attend BOD meeting well in time. The birth of Lions Club of Imphal in Manipur at the fag end of 1960s was a boon in disguise to the entire northeast region because of the fact that a cosmopolitan approach to eradicate human miseries had become a common goal for all the Lions of Manipur and much later than this, a lucid Slogan - "When there is a need, there is a Lion" was born.

At the beginning of the spread of Lionism in India, in the northeast there were only 9 Lions Clubs viz., (1) Lions Club of Digboi (1958-59), (2) Lions Club of Duliajan (1963-64), (3) Lions Club of Shillong (1963-64), (4) Lions Club of Tinsukia (1964-65), (5) Lions Club of Ledo Valley (1964-65), (6) Lions Club of Dibrugarh (1964-65), (7) Lions Club of Narangi (1965-66), (8) Lions Club of Jorhat (1965-66) and (9) Lions Club of Imphal (1967-68).
