About the Club:

Lions Club of Imphal was sponsored by Lions Club of Shillong and was inaugurated on 14th March 1968 and chartered on 22nd June 1968. Our Club has dedicated more than 56 years to humanitarian service. At present, the Club has 3 PMJF and 15 MJF members and many more DFF members of different categories. The Club has been awarded International President's Excellence Award multiple times. The Club has produced three District Governors. Our Club has hosted 5 District Conferences and had hosted 5 District Cabinet Installation and District Cabinet Meetings. The Club has achieved Bronze Level recognition 2023 of the Presidential Club Giving Award for LCIF programme.

The present Board of Directors is headed by Lion L. Swamikanta Singh, MJF as the President and was installed on 22nd June 2023 by the installation officer, Lion Dr. W. Gopimohan Singh, PMJF District Governor (2022-23), District 322D.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT:

1. In the period under report, the Club has convened 25 BOD meetings, 2 Special BOD Meeting along with 22 Regular Meetings and 2 Special Regular Meeting.
2. The Lionistic Year opened with 89 Club members. During the year, 9 members were dropped and 11 members are enrolled. Thus, the Lionistic Year 2023-24 ended with 91 members.
3. Key office bearers of the Club had attended the PST Schooling for Clubs of Manipur State held on 20th August 2023 for LY 2023-24 and on 16th June 2024 for LY 2024-25.
4. Members of the Club attended the 3rd District Cabinet Meeting with GAT Conclave on 7th January 2024. The Club had received various District Awards, 2022-23 for Category-I Clubs during the occasion.
5. The office bearers of the Club attended the 1st DG Advisory Committee Meeting for Zone-XVII/ Region-VIII on 2nd October 2023. The Club & Lions Club of Nambol had co-hosted the 2nd DGAM on 30th December 2023. Again on 29th March 2024, the Club co-hosted the 3rd DGAM with Lions Club of Imphal Galaxy.
6. The District Governor had made his official visitation to the Club on 10th December 2023. New members were inducted by the visiting District Governor.
7. The emerging Lion leaders of the Club had attended CLLI of Manipur Region on 25.12.2023.
8. Lion H. Manikumar Singh, MJF, PDG attended the 51st ISAME Forum at Dhaka in December 2023, where he was honoured with appreciation pin by (then) Immediate Past President Brian Sheehan.
9. The Secretary of the Club completed the ELLI Schooling of MD-322, which was held at Kolkata from 10-12 January 2024.
10. The Club has paid all the International & District dues for LY 2023-24.
11. The President of the Club was felicitated by International President on 10th February 2024 at Kolkata for adding 5 members to the Club during the period October to December 2023.

12. Members of the Club had attended “Dibrucon”, the 45th District Conference of District 322D at Dibrugarh on 6-7th April 2024.
13. Members of the Club had attended Installation, Charter Celebration, District Governor Visitation of many Clubs in the State held in the Lionistic Year under report.

ACTIVITIES REPORT:

Permanent Projects:

- The Club along with Lions Eye Hospital & Services Trust undertook 22 vision check-up OPDs with donation of spectacles. About 250 persons were benefitted.
- Observed Patriots’ Day 2023 on 13th August 2024 along with “Voluntary Blood Donation Camp” was held at the Blood Bank of RIMS, Lamphelpat which was organized by the Club along with Lions Club of Imphal Valley, Lions Club of Imphal Northern Hemisphere and Indian Red Cross Society, Imphal West District Branch.
- Five retired teachers were honoured in connection with observance of Teachers’ Day 2023 on 10th September 2023.
- UN Day was observed on 24th October 2024 with distribution of umbrellas to street vendors and 31st All Manipur Debating Competition for Intermediate Students.
- The Club had honoured its Past Presidents on 24th December 2024.
- The Club took up “International Childhood Cancer Day” 2024 on 15th February 2024 at the Paediatric Cancer Ward of JNMIS Hospital, Porompat by distributing medicines and nutritious food items children undergoing treatment.

One Multiple One Activity:

- Under “Joy of Giving Support to LCIF” members of the Club had made donation to LCIF totaling Rs. 3,68,900.00 (approx. \$4,404.00) in LY 2023-24. From this activity, Lion Manas Maisnam has completed both PMJF-1 and PMJF-2 while Lion Kh. Yaiphaba Meetei, Lion Dr. Shyamkumar Laishram and Lion L. Swamikanta Singh completed MJF programme.
- The Club has made a donation of Rs. 10,000/- to DFF during LY 2023-24.
- World Diabetes Day 2023 was observed on 14th November 2023 by distributing Diabetes Awareness pamphlets.
- International Women’s Day, 2024 was jointly organized by Lions Club of Imphal & Nirvana Foundation, Imphal on 9th March 2024 with awareness lectures delivered by Lion Dr. T. Bilashini Devi, MJF DC Breast & Cervical Cancer & Mrs. Shreema Ningombam, Asst. Prof (Political Science), Nambol L. Sanoi College.
- As observance of World Environment Day 2024, members of the Club had planted tree saplings at ISKCON Temple complex on 5th June 2024.

Celebrate Community:

Celebrate Community, which is a collaborative effort of Lions International, Rotary International, Kiwanis International and Optimists International Clubs was carried out by the Club in association with Rotary Club and RIMS, Lamphelpat with a free medical camp for Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) staying at Phayeng High School Relief Camp on 16th September 2023. Food and other essential items were also handed over to the residents of the Camp.

Other Service Projects:

- Under Environment Project, members of the Club had planted tree saplings at Mayang Langjing Taning on 22nd July 2023. Dr. T. Brajakumar Singh, Joint Director Environment & Climate Change had delivered an awareness lecture on “E-Waste Management” at the Service Centre. An E-Waste Collection and Management Project

under the theme “Dump or Donate” was held on 22nd October 2023 in association with Lions Club of Nambol & CRED, Naoremthong.

- Peace Poster Contest on the theme “Dare to Dream” was held on 10th September 2023 at the Service Centre of the Club.
- The Club, in association with DECA Multi-specialty Dental Clinic, Imphal had observed World Service Day, 2023 on 8th October 2023 at Chanura Leikol, Khurai with (i) Vision Screening and (ii) Dental Check-up girl residents with distribution of food items under Relieving the Hunger.
- The Club had observed 145th Birthday of Melvin Jones on 13th January 2024 by taking up the following service activities- (i) Eye Check-Up OPD and (ii) Diabetes Screening (One Multiple One Activity). Members of the Club took Lions Rededication Pledge.
- The Club donated food items to Old Age Home, Mongsangei which was sponsored by Lion W. Bhaktaraj Singh, PMJF in memory of his late father. Other members had made monetary donation to the Home during the activity.
- On 28th January 2024, the Club, in association with Lions Club of Moirang distributed food items to IDPs staying at Terakhongshangbi Relief Camp. An Eye Screening OPD and Diabetes Detection Camp were also organized.
- Lions Club of Imphal, in association with Directorate of Family Welfare Services, Govt. of Manipur took up Pulse Polio Immunization on 3rd March 2024.
- The Club had provided chicken pox medicines along with other essential hygiene items worth about Rs. 25,000/- on 21st March 2024 to Chanura Leikol Children Home for Girls, Khurai.
- The Club had participated in the distribution of relief materials at various locations in the State under the District Level “Manipur Crisis Relief Project” funded by LCIF India.
- Members of the Club had also donated Rs. 1.47 lakh to the Manipur Crisis Relief Committee, constituted by Lions Club of Manipur Region.
- Lions Club of Imphal had contributed a sum of Rs. 20,000/- to “Hailstorm Disaster Relief Committee” constituted by Lions Clubs of Manipur region and participated in distribution of relief materials.
- On 3rd June 2024, the Club had extended financial and material assistance to Poirei Nawakon Children Home for Girls, Achanbigei which was inundated in the recent flash flood.
- Lions Club of Imphal had observed World Peace Day, 2023, Lamyamba Hijam Irabot Birthday on 30th September 2023 and Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd October, 2023.
- A Fund Raising Project in the form of lucky draw was held on 24th December 2023. Approximately Rs. 2.50 lakh could be raised, which was used for Service Projects of the Club.
